Applicants are required to have an earned PhD in Mechanical Engineering or related field with specialization in Thermofluids Engineering from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate OR a Masters degree qualification (plus a PhD registration) in the above listed area of specialization from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases). They must also have a minimum of three (3) years teaching and research experience at university level or in research or in industry in the relevant area. The applicant must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals, two (2) scholarly book chapters OR; two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers OR; two (2) published teaching/lecture modules. The applicant must be registered with the Engineers Board of Kenya and demonstrate evidence of community service.
