Degree in any of the following fields: Computer Science or Electrical/ Telecommunications Engineering or an equivalent qualifications plus five (5) years experience at the level of Chief ICT Officer, Grade 12 **OR** BSc. in the above mentioned plus ten (10) years experience at the level of Chief ICT Officer Grade 12. In addition they must: have worked in network management in a corporate environment for at least five (5) years, have at least three (3) years experience in Network team management and have professional certifications in Networking
- Possess the following: technical skills in network infrastructure and service management, effective communication and interpersonal skills and good systems analytical skills
