Applications are invited for the following position:

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (THEMATIC UNIT OF OTORHINOLARYNGOLOGY, HEAD AND NECK SURGERY) DEPT. OF SURGERY – AC/1/4/21 (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants must be holders Ph.D degree or equivalent and M.Med degree or equivalent qualification in the field of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate. They must also have a minimum of eight (8) years teaching experience, three (3) of which must have been at Senior Lecturer level/Senior Research Fellow or three (3) years of industry experience in the relevant field. The applicant must have supervised to completion a minimum of five (5) postgraduate students, at least two (2) at Doctoral level and three (3) at Masters level OR a minimum of ten (10) students at Masters level. He/she must have a minimum of thirty two (32) publication points from peer reviewed journals with a minimum of five (5) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion OR a minimum of three (3) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly book chapters or two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers or two (2) published teaching/lecture modules since last promotion. He/she must have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as a Senior Lecturer/Senior Research Fellow since his/her last promotion. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be registered with relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will be expected to provide academic leadership, teach and supervise at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. They will also be expected to carry out research, be involved in clinical work at Kenyatta National Hospital and participate in Departmental, School, College and University activities.
