He/she must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed journals or two (2) scholarly book chapters or two (2) scholarly published teaching modules or two (2) peer reviewed working/occasional/discussion papers. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be registered with a relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidates will amongst other duties be expected to: teach both undergraduate and postgraduate students, carry out research in his area of specialization.
