Applications are invited for the following position:

PROFESSOR (ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY), FACULTY OF LAW – AC/11/37/25 (R&T), 2 POSTS

Applicants must be holders of a PhD degree in Environmental Policy or an equivalent qualification from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate.

They must have at least ten (10) years teaching experience at both undergraduate and postgraduate degree level, three (3) of which must be at Associate Professor Level.

They must have supervised to completion at least three (3) students at doctoral level and five (5) students at masters level OR a minimum of two (2) students at doctoral level and nine (9) students at masters level OR a minimum of fifteen (15) masters students.

Applicants must have a minimum of thirty nine (39) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of six (6) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion OR; a minimum of four (4) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly book chapters in last promotion OR; a minimum of four (4) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occasional paper, or two (2) scholarly published teaching modules since last promotion.

They must also have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as an associate professor since last promotion. They should be registered with the relevant professional body where applicable and must also show evidence of community service.
