SENIOR LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF GEOSPATIAL AND SPACE TECHNOLOGY, FACULTY OF ENGINEERING, AC/11/44/25 (R&T), 1 POST

An applicant must be a holder of an earned PhD in Geospatial Engineering in any of the following fields: Surveying, Geodesy, Photogrammetry, Cartography, GIS and Remote Sensing, or equivalent qualifications from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate.

He/she must have a minimum of three (3) years teaching experience as a Lecturer/Research Fellow at the university or a minimum of six (6) years of industry experience in Geospatial Engineering; have supervised to completion at least one (1) postgraduate student at doctoral level and one (1) at master's level OR A minimum of three (3) masters students; have attained a minimum of 24 publication points from peer-reviewed journals with: a minimum of four (4) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion OR A minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly book chapters OR a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly published teaching/lecture modules or two (2) working/occasional/discussion/papers since last promotion; have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as a Lecturer/Research Fellow since last promotion; have evidence of community service; have registered with a relevant professional body.
